Intro: G C- ↷D- G C- ↷D-

G C- ↷D- G C- ↷D- G

You'll say, we've got nothing in common, no common ground to start from

C- ↷D- G C- ↷D-

Fill: As intro.

G C- ↷D- G C- ↷D- G

I see you, the only one who knew me, but now your eyes see through me

C- ↷D- G C- ↷D-

— I guess I was wrong

G C- ↷D- G C- ↷D- G

So what now? It's plain to see we're over, and I hate when things are over

C- ↷D- G C- ↷D-

When so much is left undone

Chorus (no fill)

Repeat verse 1

Chorus

Fill x2

Chorus x2

Fill x2 - end on G

↷ indicates a 'push' rhythm where the chord change is ahead of the beat — on the previous up-strum rather than on the down-strum.
